Pink in the Rink

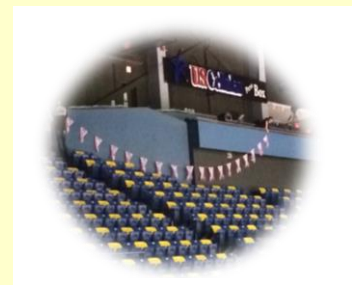
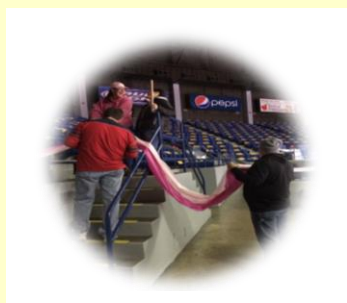

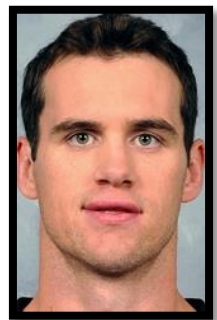
